

### Drills

### NUT Day

Thursday, August 25, will be our first NUT (No Uniform Today) Day. Students will earn this NUT day if they do not have a uniform infraction during the month of August. Teachers will let students know on August 24 if they have not earned the NUT Day. Please remember on NUT days, students come out of uniform, but must still wear appropriate shoes/clothing. Crocs and sandals are not allowed for students in grades K-6. Please refer to the handbook or ask if you have more questions. We have a NUT day at the end of the month for students with no infractions. Occasionally we will have \$1 NUT days to raise money for a cause. Students also receive a NUT day card for their birthday.

### Grandparent's Day

Sacred Heart will celebrate Grandparent's Day on Friday, September 9. On this day, grandparents will be invited to join their students for Mass at 8:15, and then can come back to the school for refreshments and see classrooms. We look forward to this day every year! This will be our next dress uniform day!

### Accelerated Reader

Students will have an Accelerated Reader goal for each quarter. The goal is a number of points. To earn points, students read (or are read to) a book and come to school to take a quiz on the book. The quizzes are on the iPads and ask comprehension questions to make sure the students are understanding what they are reading. When a student meets his/her goal, they get their picture taken and posted on the wall in the hallway as well as receive a NUT day card. There is also a place in the main hallway outside the gym where we track the number of words students have read. I do try to post pictures on our social media occasionally.
